

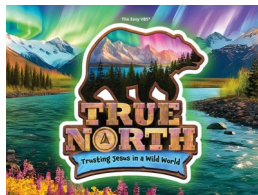

Nathan's Notes...

"I can deal with anything for a little while." This is how we make it through so many of the challenges of life. A child endures their school work because they know a summer vacation is eventually coming. A teenager makes it through all their classes because they see graduation on the horizon. A mother endures labor because she knows it will soon end and she will get to hold her child in her arms. Exhausted parents endure sleepless nights because they know their baby will eventually be able to sleep for longer periods of time. A tired worker continues his job because he knows his vacation is coming soon or that a promotion will eventually happen. A gardener keeps weeding on a hot day because he anticipates a good harvest in the next few months. We find motivation when we hope for something better in the future.

That was the apostle Paul's motivation that kept him working through a very challenging and demanding ministry and that can be ours as well. The fact is that we can deal with a lot as long as we see something better coming at the other end. As we are considering the need for motivation, let's keep in mind that one of the most powerful motivators is the promise that Christ has made to us for a future life with Him.
