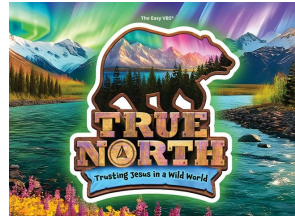

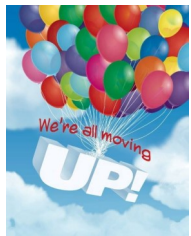
Home-Bound Communion–

Nathan's Notes...

One of our major focuses this year in the way of producing good fruit for Christ is the proper use of spiritual gifts- abilities given to God's people through His Spirit that enable them to better serve their Lord. Today we will be discussing an often overlooked, but very important spiritual gift we find in scripture. Romans 12:6-7 encourages... *"Since we have gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, each of us is to exercise them accordingly...if service, in his serving..."* We're told something similar when 1 Corinthians 12:28 speaks of God appointing people in His church who have the gift of "helps".

Service is one of those things that all Christians are called to take part in. If serving others was not below Christ, it is certainly not below any of us. However, as with many virtuous acts of these sorts, we find that some people seem to excel in it. They love serving and they love the people they serve. They have a great passion for it. They can see the value in providing for others' needs, even when the rest of us would be unmotivated or disenfranchised. The fact is, the church would be nowhere near where it is now without people who are gifted with a heart to serve.
