

Rick's Reflections...

Very few congregations have the privilege of seeing what Eastview has seen over the last 28 years with the amazing North India Christian Mission story. Today we are blessed to have Simmi and her son Suraj with us to report on the missions progress and celebrate God's faithfulness in leading and providing for this work.

Because there are so many folks worshipping with us today who may not know the genesis of this work I want to take a few moments and give some background. For the veterans who can tell the story themselves my hope is today will be a positive refresher of the incredible way God orchestrated what we are celebrating today.

From the humble beginnings to a legitimate church planting movement Simmi and her team has seen a continued growth in spite of persecution and other challenges. Putting the need in perspective, there are nearly one billion in that country who desperately need to know Christ. They speak over 300 different languages, and many are without adequate resources.

We are blessed to have a great ministry partner in IDES who has been providing food and other supplies so that our pastors can demonstrate the love of Christ in tangible ways. This has opened many doors for witnessing in the past and continues to be a vital part of the outreach today.
