Nathan's Notes...

Happy 4th of July. I hope everyone had a very blessed Independence Day. In honor of this national holiday, we will be addressing the concept of citizenship in the message.

Citizenship is a hot-button topic today. Who should have it? How important is it? What rights and protections can we guarantee for people who don't have it? To the approval of some and the disapproval of others, we're not talking about those questions today. Today we will be discussing a topic of citizenship that is much much more important than anything that can be offered us by earthly governments: citizenship in the kingdom of Heaven.

The book of Philippians makes it clear: if you are in Christ, you are a citizen of His eternal kingdom. But just like with earthly citizenships, that is much more than a title. It comes with certain benefits and obligations. We'll discuss what that looks like as we dive into the concept of our heavenly citizenship.
