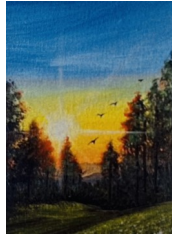

Nathan's Notes...

Today we will be beginning a short series on the Holy Spirit. The Bible often refers to the "Holy Spirit" or the "Spirit of God", but we can sometimes gloss over any related theology. I think this will be a helpful study for a couple of reasons.

First, lack of knowledge about the Holy Spirit is a common problem among Christians. In some churches, He's been largely overlooked, having been referred to as the "Forgotten God". In some other churches, He's so heavily focused on that nearly everything is attributed to Him, including every stray thought, idea, or emotion. But if we're to "live by the Spirit" as Romans 8 encourages us, we need to have an accurate understanding of Him.

But secondly, I think that getting a better understanding of the Spirit will help us to better understand some of the spiritual gifts He equips us with. If you'll remember, one our main focus- es this year is the giftedness we need in order to produce good fruit for Christ. My hope is that if we can better understand God's Spirit and the role He plays in our lives, we may be better able to understand how to live out the gifts He provides.
