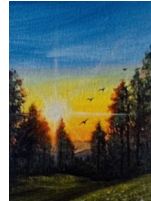

Nathan's Notes...

All throughout the Bible we get various statements and descriptions of both the Father and of Jesus that help us understand their nature on a deep and somewhat philosophical level. Interestingly, we don't seem to get as direct and thorough explanations of the Holy Spirit. That's not to say that there isn't much we can learn about Him through various scriptural references and hints. If you were here last week, you will remember that we touched upon many passages to gain a deeper understanding of His identity. But there's not as much direct treatment of His nature in the Bible. When He is mentioned, it seems He is often described in terms of the work He does, which actually goes a long way in helping us understand Him.

This week we will be learning about the Holy Spirit in light of what He does. As already shown in this series, He does a lot, but we see so much of His interaction with us coming down to a simple concept. We'll examine that concept today as we look more closely at the work of the Spirit.
