Rick's Reflections...

What comes to your mind when you hear the term, "great faith"? For many it is a term describing some biblical hero or maybe a missionary in a far away country. In reality it is not necessarily about the quantity of faith, but rather the quality and depth of one's belief and reliance on God. Today we will be looking at how Jesus used the term and learn something about a deep, unwavering faith. This kind of faith is demonstratable.

An interesting fact in Scripture is that there are several Centurions mentioned in the gospels. It seems that each of them were in a sense "not far from the Kingdom of God." (Mark 12:34) Take some time to survey these antidotes and reflect on their significance.

- 1) The one in Capernaum whose servant is healed (Luke 7:1-10)
- 2) The one at the crucifixion (Matt. 27:54)
- 3) Cornelius – (Acts 10:22)

There were centurions who guarded Paul and accompanied him on his trip to Rome that showed faith as well. Remember all of these men were gentiles, they had no Jewish background. They were foreigners, outsiders, but they saw something that made an impact on them. So, when considering our faith, we must ask what does it look like to others? James 2:17-19 says, "In the same way, faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead. 18 But someone will say, "You have faith; I have deeds." Show me your faith without deeds, and I will show you my faith by my deeds. 19 You believe that there is one God. Good! Even the demons believe that, and shudder."

The kid's teaching method of "Show and Tell" comes to mind here.
