Reaching People FOR Christ and
Building People UP IN Christ
September 14, 2025



Nathan's Notes...

Today we are continuing our series "Rubber to the Road", in which we look at more detail on the important topic of service. Christ has called His people to be branches that bear "much fruit", that is, to be a people who produce good things in this world for His sake. The more we are driven to serve people like Jesus did, the more fruit will come naturally from our lives.

Today we're looking at a parable of Jesus that describes those who love and serve Him as sheep and those that refuse as goats. This can be a challenging scripture for a few reasons, but my goal is that, by the end, we will have a greater appreciation for what it means to serve and a greater motivation to do so. This motivation will come when we understand exactly what our service to others in Jesus' name means. It's more than simply kind acts and friendly helping. Our Lord affirms in this passage that when we serve people in need, we are, in an amazing way, actually serving Him.
