Eastview Parking Lot Repairs:

We have scheduled both the **north asphalt parking area** and **main entrance concrete ramp** repairs to commence weather permitting on **Tuesday, October 7th and continuing thru Saturday, October 18th.**

The north asphalt area will involve some repairs, and seal coating requiring vehicular traffic stay off the barricaded area for only a couple days.

Hopefully, the asphalt area will be available for Sunday parking.

The concrete entrance ramp will be barricaded off for likely two to three weeks.

This will require all vehicular traffic to enter thru the northeast entrance nearest the barn. Directional signage will be placed to assist everyone.

Exercise caution as all traffic will be utilizing the one entrance for a couple weeks.

Nathan's Notes...

As we finish our series "Rubber to the Road", I want to talk about a powerful factor in our ability and desire to serve: our freedom. As 21st century Americans, we often associate the concept of "freedom" as societal or governmental in nature. But long before the idea of "freedom of the people" came the explicitly Christian idea of "freedom of the faithful".

Perhaps we should think less of our obligation to serve and more of our freedom to serve. Yes, we produce good fruit because our God desires us to. Yes, we love our neighbors as ourselves because Christ told us to. But we also serve because we are FREE to serve, no longer slaves to the things that restrict our life to sin and confinement. Through the work of God in us, we are made ABLE to live for something bigger and greater than ourselves. This is freedom at work in us.
