Eastview Parking Lot Repairs:

Parking lot repairs have started on the north asphalt parking area and main entrance concrete ramp.

Work will continue thru Saturday, October 18th.

The concrete entry apron and handicap curb at the building entry are completed, as well as the asphalt patch areas. Seal coating is finished and striping has started. The concrete entrance ramp will be barricaded off for likely two to three weeks.

This will require all vehicular traffic to enter thru the northeast entrance nearest the barn.

Directional signage will be placed to assist everyone.

Exercise caution as all traffic will be utilizing the one entrance for a couple weeks.
