Rick's Reflections...

A website promoting a certain University posted an article touting "Simple Ways to Save Yourself." It was full of the typical "it's all about you" philosophy.

Advising students to: 1.) Forget about how you feel, it will pass.

- 2.) Ease up on internal life commentary, 3.) Give up on feeling guilty.
- 4.) If you don't like the way you are, make yourself different, etc.

And we wonder why the wheels seem to be coming off our society. In Ephesians 2, Paul speaks of a very different concept of the saving of ourselves. Acknowledging that all of us were trapped in the downward pull of sin, he reminds us of our complete spiritual helplessness. We "were dead in [our]... sins" (vs.1). We were trapped, obeying the devil and refusing to submit to God. (vs.2) This resulted in being the subject of God's wrath. "But because of his great love for us" (vs.4), He didn't leave us trapped in spiritual darkness. For those who believe in Jesus, the apostle wrote, "by grace... have been saved" (vv. 5, 8). A response to God's rescue initiative results in faith. And faith means we'll give up on trying to save ourselves and call on Jesus to rescue us. Praise God that true rescue, true salvation, does not originate with us. It's "the gift of God" through Jesus alone (v. 8).
