Nathan's Notes...

Faith in Christ, while undoubtedly the greatest path a person can follow, is not without its obstacles. The common portrayal of a person whose life comes together and whose problems become solved when they finally decide to make Jesus their Lord is heartwarming, but often inaccurate. We live in a fallen, imperfect world (at least for the time being) and that means that even the most noble of efforts can hit snags. There is no doubt that we deal with a number of expected limitations: scarcity, fear, setbacks, and even outright opposition from people who Satan has manipulated. That's why it is so important that we keep our mission and goal in perspective.

As we near the end of our year of focusing on the need to produce "much fruit", I want to examine several of the common setbacks we encounter in serving our Lord. These "Roadblocks" can be very discouraging if not seen as part of the unavoidable challenges of life in Christ. Today we will begin this series by looking at a common deterrent to devoted service: scarcity of resources, or famine.
