Nathan's Notes...

As we conclude our series on "Roadblocks", the problems that get in the way of our service to God, we're going to discuss an inevitable problem: direct opposition. People standing up to oppose our service to God is often a shocking thing, but it should not surprise us. 2 Timothy 3:12 says, "Indeed, all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus will be persecuted." The reality is that whereas God and His mission are perfectly good, human hearts are not.

But the question is, "How do we respond in the face of such opposition?" That's what we will examine today as we study the story of Nehemiah rebuilding the walls around Jerusalem and the opposition he faced.
