"It's the most wonderful time of the year" as the popular Christmas song puts it. It then goes on to list a number of the things that make this season so wonderful, including friends meeting, parties, marshmallows, caroling, and scary ghost stories (I never understood that last one and don't recommend it). We could add to the list Christmas lights, cookie exchanges, gifts, and hot chocolate. But perhaps the thing that really makes Christmas special is how personal it is meant to be.

All our celebrations of this time of year ultimately reach back a long time ago to the story of the birth of Jesus. What really makes this the most wonderful time of the year is that this is not just some far-removed story we tell from tradition. It's a personal story. It's a story that includes us. Of course we weren't present at Christ's birth, but it was intended for us. When an angel appeared to the shepherds outside of Bethlehem, they were told it was good news that would be "for all the people". Christmas is special still because it's FOR us even 2000 years later. When God sent His Son as a gift, it affected our lives, our stories.
