



Nathan's Notes...

I hope everyone had a good Christmas! The Sunday after Christmas and before New Year's often feels awkward. We're tired from activity, we're done with the last big event of the year, but we're still waiting for the next year to get started. I've heard that in ministry circles this day is often humorously called "Youth Minister Sunday" because it's the day that the senior minister takes to rest and has the youth minister preach.

But I want to treat today a little differently this year (and not just because we don't have a youth minister on staff). I want to use this day to finish up our ongoing discussion of spiritual gifts. As we close 2025 and it's focus on our need to serve, I want to spend a little time talking about how we should understand and practice our gifts. This has not been an easy message to prepare, in part because at least some of this topic includes things that can, sadly, be controversial and divisive among Christians. But there is no need to fear that when our goal is to speak where the Bible speaks and be silent where it is silent, and to always relate to each other in love and goodwill. There may be parts of the message today that may seem overly technical or theologically deep, but being in the word of God, they are important. And I think we'll see that as we discuss three principles for practicing our gifts, we'll find the things we cover to be of greater and greater importance.
