# MINISTRY IN MOTION

Reaching People FOR Christ and  
Building People UP IN Christ

### Nathan's Notes...

Every now and then, my wife and I go to one of my favorite restaurants in the area. It's a nice place that specializes in some cajun style dishes. But the real draw for me is the fact that they have live jazz music in the evenings. I found that I love going on Monday nights because that is essentially their "open mic" night. Many of the people who perform are average people from around town. Most of them do not look like jazz musicians or anything special, for that matter. They are just average, everyday people. But I'm often amazed at the amount of talent they display. They seem to be nothing special, but they carry something incredible inside.

This is similar to the concept we are studying today. Paul writes about his and others' ministry in carrying the Gospel of Christ. It is an unsurpassable treasure, yet it is held by average, ordinary people. Thus he refers to it as treasure in jars of clay.

The reality is that all of us, as God's people, carry a great treasure in the Gospel. After all, it is, as Romans puts it, the "power to salvation for all who believe". But what does it mean to be a "jar of clay"? We'll look at this description and how it impacts our lives today.
