Rick's Reflections...

Proving something suggests that there would be some evidence, verification, or confirmation that what is being stated is true. Proving faithful to our Lord requires a conscious, ongoing choice to be loyal and unwavering in belief, expressed through our actions.

Jesus told a parable to His disciples in Matthew chapter 25. A man entrusted some treasure to his servants while he went away. When he came back, he evaluated how faithful the servants were with the treasure. The definition of faithful is “unwavering in belief, consistently loyal.” Faithfulness is an important character quality that all of us want to see in those we love and trust. God wants the same from us.

The Apostle Paul told a young Christian leader named Timothy to “continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of, because you know those from whom you learned it.” (2 Timothy 3:14)

God is faithful. He is trustworthy to those whom He loves and who place their trust in Him. God desires that we also be faithful to Him, to be unwavering in belief and consistently loyal to Him. How encouraging it is to know that God is the one who enables us to live faithfully as we choose to do so. We make the choice. He empowers us to live out that choice.

Do you want to hear, “Well done, good and faithful servant”? Do you want others to hear it as well? Then live it out to the best of your ability and trust Him for the rest.
