Nathan's Notes...

Today we are half-way through our series that comes from suggestions and questions from our church family. We began two weeks ago by discussing the relationship between faith and works. Last week we addressed a number of questions that our children asked and I think we all learned how smart and inquisitive Eastview kids are. Today, we will continue by studying the very short book of Jude, which is about the dangers of false teaching.

Jude is a challenging book for a few reasons. There are a number of statements in it that, even if you are well-versed in your Bible, you may have no idea what he's talking about, because he appeals to apocryphal, or non-canonical, stories. I'll try to touch on what that is in the message today, but for time's sake we will not be able to address it in detail. Jude is also challenging because he takes a very harsh, and what may seem to be an unchristian, attitude toward false teachers. But as I think we'll see, when put into perspective, his strong words and anger are justified. But one of the most challenging things about Jude is that it calls us to draw a line in the sand, to speak boldly about falsehood, and to not mince words about the importance of truth.
