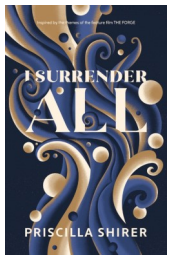

Nathan's Notes...

Having finished our month focusing on prayer, we will begin to turn our attention back to our theme for the year: Deep Roots. Throughout 2024, we are focusing on building a strong understanding of the essentials of Christianity and so establish a good foundation in the faith. But throughout this process, we may find that there are times that doubts arise. Perhaps we question something about God or feel unsure of something we once held to or struggle to accept something we read in the Bible. Experiencing doubts can be a very unsettling experience for the Christian who is trying to build their identity on Christ, but the good news is that the Bible is not silent on this matter. Today we will look at the account of a man who struggled with doubts; a man we might not think would: John the Baptist. We'll see the cause and nature of his doubting as well as Jesus' response.
