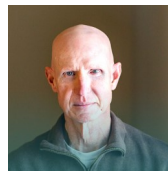

Nathan's Notes...

In the evenings, when I go outside to close up our chicken coop, I usually have to take a flashlight with me. But for the past few nights, I've not needed one. Rather I step outside, after the sun has set and am greeted with one of the most beautiful sights I encounter in my day: a dark night, beautifully lit up by the moon's reflection on the snow. I often stand there a few moments and take in the surreal scenery I would never see on a normal night. Ironically, the amount of light is the same as any other night, but the terrain is much easier to traverse due to how much light is reflected back by the snow.

In John 8, Jesus calls Himself "the Light of the world". But in Matthew 5, He calls His followers the light of the world. It seems clear to me that we are "light" by imitation. By first knowing Him and imitating His goodness, we mimic Him in being a light in a dark place, showing the way to the Father in Heaven. However, just like the snow reflects the light of the moon, we have no light without first receiving it from Him. It is ultimately in Christ that we find our example of what it looks like to be light in a dark world and so fulfill our commission in Philippians 2 to shine like stars.
