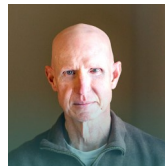

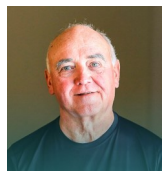

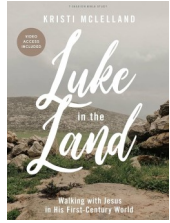

Nathan's Notes...

It's the day of our annual congregation meeting. If you're new to Eastview, you will notice that things will be a little different from normal. We will still have a time of worship through song, observe the Lord's supper, and study a passage of scripture. But we will be doing several different things as well.

Today you will hear a report on some highlights from 2024, including our giving and financial activity as well as our projected budget for next year. This report will only be a brief overview, but extra information will be available in the lobby.

We will also be asking the congregation to make a vote of affirmation for several leadership positions, all of which are men who are currently serving. To be clear, this is not to vote them "into" or "back into" their roles. Rather the elders are asking the congregation for affirmation of the men they have already chosen for these tasks.

Finally, I will be discussing the focus of our teaching for this year. It is clear to me that God has been working through the people of Eastview and continues to do so. Our goal going forward should be to be the most willing vessels possible for His purposes. Our best chance of becoming that is when we pursue Him together.
