If you're anything like me, sometimes you feel drained. It's almost like we have a battery full of motivation and energy. Throughout the day, different things drain or charge that battery. Wake up feeling under the weather? That battery is starting low. Does something go well at work? It feels like that battery fills up a little. Are you busy with constant demands on your time? The battery gets drained quickly and you can't wait to get back home to recharge it.

I bring up this analogy because it feels like almost nothing drains the battery faster than anxiety. When worrisome thoughts run through our minds and "what if" scenarios dominate our focus, we feel too exhausted to do much of anything, let alone live at our fullest to be fruitful Christians.
