Nathan's Notes...

For a few weeks now we've been looking at some things scripture tells us help to "nourish the branch", that is, to help us be stronger and more fruitful followers of Christ. We started by looking at worship and saw that it helps us to put life into perspective so that we are able to fix our attention on serving God. Then we saw how the word of God nurtures us by producing necessary changes in our lives. And last week we talked about the anxiety that so quickly drains us of all energy and motivation and how greater trust in God helps us to grow through it.

This week, our topic is a challenging one. As much as we don't like to face hardship, scripture makes it clear that God uses it to help us grow. Inherently, we all understand that hardships are inevitable, but we often want it to be minimal in our own lives. It reminds me of an old song by the Ink Spots:

"Into each life some rain must fall,

But too much is falling in mine."

But as much as the topic of hardship may seem to be an unpleasant one, it is actually one filled with good news about God's amazing ability to bring great things out of the sufferings we face.
