Reaching People FOR Christ and Building People UP IN Christ March 30, 2025



Nathan's Notes...

For the past five weeks we've been looking at how various things contribute to our walk with Christ and our ability to serve Him as fruitful Christians. This has included practices that we are responsible for such as worship, fellowship, and studying the Bible; as well as how we respond to things that happen to us, such as pursuing trust in the midst of anxiety and endurance in the midst of hardship. God works in all our lives to push us to be productive followers of Christ, but He will not force us. The ultimate responsibility is on ourselves to decide to bear fruit for Him.

But our final topic in this series is one that many of us will find most challenging, not because we don't want to or are unable to, but because we live in a world that runs at a pace so contrary to it. Today we're discussing the importance of rest. Nearly everyone will agree that rest is important, but we find it much harder in practice. Let's look at how the Bible presents this concept and why it is so important to our faith.
