
**SAVE THE DATE!**

Nathan's Notes...

Last week at our annual congregational meeting, I introduced the teaching focus of this year: "In This Together". The fact is that we are made for close, personal relationships, not just as Christians and members of the body of Christ, but as human beings. All around us we see the negative effects of a lack of meaningful connections, but today I want to begin approaching the topic from a more positive view.

Why is it that we are meant to be together? Over the next several weeks, I plan to address "The Reason for 'Together'" and we begin today with a fascinating statement of both philosophical and theological significance: God is light.
