Rick's Reflections...

This morning, we will be looking at an issue that applies to all of us, no matter what "position" we find ourselves in. The first disciples were not the only people to struggle with the idea of humble leadership. As we will see, the lessons they will learn are ones we should pay close attention to. Leadership always involves a relationship. It is a people thing, and we are part of the equation.

Charles Spurgeon said, "Humility is to make a right estimate of oneself." C. S. Lewis positively defined humility as "not thinking less of yourself but as thinking of yourself less." Really good leaders respect other people. They strive to lift them and to inspire them to do their best. They are motivated by purpose, not by personal ambition. They don't yield to the arrogance of power.

Over the next four months, starting in April, as part of my duties as Leadership Development Minister, we will be providing a "Leadership Development" opportunity on the first Tuesday of the month from 6:00 to 7:30. This first round is open to any man who would like to take a deeper dive into what it means to lead well, especially as a Christ follower. Please let me know if you would like to participate. We will be repeating the opportunity for the ladies, hopefully in the fall.

Jesus wants us to serve without asking "what's in it for me?" He is the ultimate example of humility. May we serve Him well as we serve others humbly.
