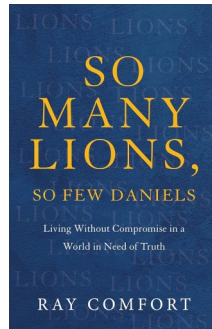

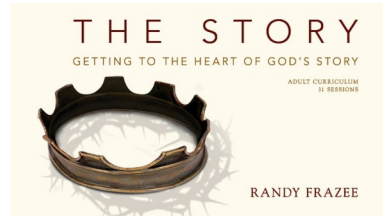
Food of the Month-
