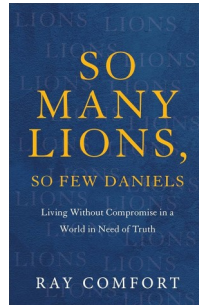

Rick's Reflections...

Several of us have started the new year taking a tour through Scripture. We are working hard to put all the pieces of this grand story together and see it for what it is, God's love story. Wisdom says, start at the beginning and that is what we are doing. As a result we find significant lessons early on. One of them is the obvious propensity we have to disobey God! And another is how good we naturally are at rationalizing our disobedience. I want to come back to that subject at a later date.

But we also are encouraged by examples of great faithfulness, especially in very trying circumstances. We are not the first believers to face cultural chaos and moral depravity. Noah stands out as a beacon of light and is used incredibly by God to keep the story alive, and mankind for that matter. One of his predecessors is the focus of our message today. Through Enoch's story God was revealing truth. And part of that truth was that there was eternal life, that men could leave this world in right relationship to Him and enter into His eternal presence. Finishing Well! That is our challenge at this point. I am reminded of a great song of the church. Find us Faithful by Steve Green speaks to my heart. I hope it inspires you as well. Part of the song says:
