Nathan's Notes...

We are now about half-way through our series on the roots of the faith. We have already studied the Creator: Father, Son, and Spirit. Today we will look at the creation, and from here we will discuss the corruption, the cure, and the culmination. My hope is that this approach will give us a good overview of the basics of the Bible and pave the way for future depths of learning.

The creation is an important topic for us because it is the realm in which we exist and interact and to which we belong. Most of what we know and experience deals with creation, which means that wherever we look, we can see the craftsmanship of the Creator. In fact, as we will see today, this is one of the main purposes of creation, to point to the glory of God. But if we are part of that creation, isn't that why we exist too?
