Nathan's Notes...

Over the past couple of months, we've studied "The Roots of the Faith", those essential building blocks that make up the Biblical message and Christian worldview. We began with three weeks spent studying our Creator: the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit and understanding Who He is, how He created everything, and how He works today. We then looked at the creation and what exactly it is. Then we studied the corruption, that is sin, and how it affects us. Then, two weeks ago on Easter, Rick explained the cure to sin, namely the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. Today, we will begin the last topic in this series with a study of the culmination: the return of Christ that will bring about the end of this present world.

We are all keenly aware of the fact that many things are only temporary: the tool you bought with a lifetime warranty, the transmission you paid to have put in your car, the job you felt would be long-term, sadly, many of us have seen first-hand that loved ones and our relationships with them do not last forever either. On the contrary, God's people await a special future that goes on for eternity. But that will only be established after the passing of this present age.
