Nathan's Notes...

Last week we began talking about the culmination of all things: the return of Christ and the subsequent ending of this age in which this world will pass away. We answered the question, "Why will this world end?" by pointing to the corruption of sin for which God's holiness demands justice. Whereas judgement is a touchy subject for some, we all inherently agree that evil should not be allowed to continue on forever. So, we understand exactly why this world will end.

This week, we'll be answering two more questions about the culmination: When will it happen and how? Whereas we may not get the answers we expect or hope for from these questions, they're still natural to ask and scripture, at the very least, addresses them. My hope is that when today is done, we will have not only a more solid grasp of God's plans for the future and our place in those plans, but a much greater understanding of the roots of the Christian faith and what all is encompassed in a truly Biblical worldview.
