Nathan's Notes...

From the very beginning, humans were made to be social creatures. In the creation account in Genesis we read that God, having made everything and declaring it to be good, looked at Adam and said that it was not good that he be alone. Throughout history, people have naturally gathered into groups. The church is the intentional gathering of God's people together. We're social creatures, made to be with others like us. This is why isolation is so disappointing and dangerous. We do better with others.

Out of this natural need of all people to connect with others comes an opportunity to share Christ. The friendships and connections we have with non-Christians are ripe avenues for communicating the Gospel. But one might ask, "Isn't using friendship to evangelize backhanded or manipulative?" Actually, it is the perfect expression of friendship because it seeks the wellbeing of another. Today we will look at the story of Matthew, one of Jesus' apostles, and how he used his personal connections to introduce people to Jesus.
