Nathan's Notes...

Last week we began our series on evangelism that we're calling "One Message, Many Methods". There is one message of one Savior by which people are saved, but how we communicate that message will not always look the same. Last week we talked about a confrontational approach to evangelism, one in which we "lay all the cards on the table" at once and communicate more directly and urgently a person's need for Christ. We talked about how, when done poorly, this can be very risky, but when done in the right situation and with the right attitude, it can be a wonderful tool.

But if you are not a confrontational person, you may find that today's style of evangelism is exactly what you resonate with: service. Love is a powerful thing and will often speak volumes to the heart where words fall short. And love is best shown through action. Today we'll talk about how to use the love of Christ in us to open the door to communicate the Gospel message.
